Thank you for your letter of 13 March 2013 asking for comment on the conduct of Social Services and their communications with Mr Dobbie.


Mr Dobbie has historically made a formal children's social care complaint. This was investigated at Stage 1 of the Children's Social Care Complaints Procedure and did not progress to Stage 2.

Mr Dobbie has also sent emails to the police, and children's social care on a daily basis. The majority of the concerns Mr Dobbie raises in his emails about his children have been investigated by both the police and children's social care.

Mr Dobbie's children are subject to interim care orders and they are placed with their mother. The children are open to the Ellesmere Port Children in Care Team.

Please be assured that whilst it would not be appropriate for me provide any specific details social services are working with the family to achieve the best outcome for the children.
